



TECHNICAL NOTES

DOMAINE ROLAND TISSIER 2023 SANCERRE BLANC

Founded in 1972, Domaine Roland Tissier is a small, 3rd generation family-estate based just outside the medieval village of Sancerre. Vineyard holdings are dominated by Oxfordian Limestone (Griottes and Caillottes) with a healthy dose of Silex, and include some of the finest parcels in the appellation.

VINEYARDS

25 acres (21 Sauvignon Blanc, 4 Pinot Noir) including some of the best sites in the appellation!

11 acres on Griottes-dominated soils (Les Grands-Champs, La Moussière, Les Veugaillères, Les Guigne-Chèvres). The rarer of Sancerre’s Oxfordian Limestone soils, marked by small limestone pebbles. These yield fruity wines that are round and mouth-filling.

9 acres on Caillottes-dominated soils (Les Grands-Champs plateau, Les Petits-Grous, Le Fort, Les Chaintres). These compact, Oxfordian white limestone soils give floral and fruity wines that are especially expressive when young.

5 acres on Silex (Le Thou, Les Coltabards, Les Palots, Les Carrés-Maréchaux, Les Fredins, Les Tirepeines, Les Chailloux). These soils provide the classic minerality and gun-flint aromas that become more expressive over time.

APPELLATION

Sancerre AOP.

COMPOSITION

100% Sauvignon Blanc.

VITICULTURE

Sustainably-grown. Vines average 35 years in age.

WINEMAKING

15 to 30 days fermentation in stainless steel tanks followed by 6 to 10 months maturation on the fine lees.

ALCOHOL

14%

TASTING NOTES

An intense and concentrated wine with great finesse and balance. Offers aromas of citrus, white fruit and floral aromas over a core of smoky, flinty minerality. Round and mouth-filling on the palate, with racy acidity and a long, mouth-watering finish.

SERVE WITH

Perfect with herb-rolled goat cheese, oysters on the half shell, crab cakes and Cobb Salad.
